GUIDELINES FOR

AWARENESS PROGRAM ON ENVIRONMENT & FOREST CONSERVATION

Section 1: The Objective:

To create awareness and sensitivity among general public, students and other target groups about the importance of conservation of forests and its ecosystem, biodiversity, wildlife and the various environmental problems created by human activities.

To enable behavioral change at the individual level and adopt measures for environment protection and conservation.

Section 2: Scope and Background

Increasing population, rapid urbanization and poverty have generated huge pressure on the natural resources and lead to degradation of the environment. To prevent the environment from further degradation, the message of conservation needs to be spread among the public at large and adopt measures to mitigate the impacts of environmental degradation.

Environmental degradation cannot be prevented by laws alone. Public participation is equally important with regard to environmental protection. The aim of environmental awareness is to make people from all walks of life aware of specific issues, such as climate change, loss of biodiversity, declining fisheries, ozone layer depletion, illegal trade in endangered species, destruction of habitats and animal corridors, land degradation, depleting ground water supplies, introduction of alien species, environmental pollution, solid wastes and sewage disposal pose a serious threat to ecosystems in forest, rural, urban and riverine ecosystems.

Section 3: Various awareness generation activities shall be adopted and few examples are given below:

- 1. Organize seminars, debates, workshops, lectures and popular talks.
- 2. Organize group field visits to environmentally important sites including polluted, dumping sites and degraded sites, National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries etc.
- 3. Organize rallies, marches, human chains, exhibitions, fairs, live concerts, folk dances and street theater at public places with a view to spread environmental awareness.
- 4. Take up activities like tree plantation and cleanliness drives.
- 5. Grow kitchen garden, maintain vermi-composting pits, construct water-harvesting structures in school, practice paper re-cycling etc.
- 6. Prepare inventories of polluting sources and forward it to enforcement agencies.
- 7. To sensitize people about maintenance of public places like parks and gardens.
- 8. Mobilize action against environmentally unsound practices like garbage disposal in unauthorized places, unsafe disposal of hospital waste etc.
- 9. Undertake case studies, compile lists of environmentally friendly products and community initiatives which have impacted the environment.
- 10. Create database on land use pattern, species diversity, medicinal plants, etc. to help planned conservation efforts.
- 11. Test soil, water and air quality and study their impact on health.
- 12. Volunteer to assist in guiding visitors of zoo, public gardens and protected areas.
- 13. Volunteers to assist in wildlife census and other biological inventorisation.
- 14. Start and maintain a small orchidarium, seed bank, arboretum, nursery, herbarium, etc. in schools.
- 15. Demonstrate/promote eco-friendly practices like non-chemical pest management, use of energy- efficient devices such as energy efficient Chulhas (stove) or use of renewable energy for meeting local needs.
- 16. Organization of film or slide shows at community centers, Schools, Colleges, Museums, etc. on environmental themes.
- 17. Choosing products that are recyclable and also products made from recycled materials.
- 18. Initiate the establishment of plant nurseries in schools, villages, etc.
- 19. Organising quiz/essay/painting/poster competitions on environment for school children.

Section 4:Eligibility criteria for organisations willing to receive grant and undertake

awareness activities:

- 1. The proponent could be a recognized academic/research institution or a government department/government undertaking with at least three years of experience of working inenvironment related fields.
- 2. The proponent could be a registered voluntary/professional organization/Trust/NGO with atleast three years experience in environment related fields and registered under the relevant provisions for a minimum of three years and raising audited accounts.
- 3. The proposal should specify the outcome expected particularly in regard to enhancement in awareness about environmental issues.
- 4. The proponent shall bear a minimum of 10% of the total cost of the proposal which could befrom the proponent own funds or from a sponsor.
- 5. The proponent shall involve a representative of the department while undertaking awareness activity.

Section 5: Screening Committee

The Environment & Forests Department shall constitute an Internal Screening Committee for consideration of such proposals. The Committee shall consider those proposals, which are complete in all respect, keeping the following aspects in view while recommending the proposal(s) for financial assistance: `

- The applicant organisation has not received any grant under this programme during the financial year in which the proposed event falls. Financial assistance would not be provided more than once in a financial year.
- Application from Government Department / undertaking / academic / research institution has been duly forwarded by Head of the institution.
- The applicant/institution has already submitted copies of audited expenditure statement, utilization certificate, report on the awareness activity undertaken and also settled other issues, if any, relating to previous grant(s) received by them from the department.
- ➤ In case of NGOs, valid registration is also a must.

Section 6: Detailed procedure for conducting awareness programs

Organization/Institutions volunteering for undertaking awareness programs with Grant-in-Aid support from E&F Department are required to follow all the procedures mentioned below:

- Only organization/institution having eligible criteria alone will be considered for granting aids to undertake awareness activity.
- (2) Eligible organization/institution shall submit the completely filled in application as per the proposed format. (Annexure A)
- (3) Internal screening committee of the department will scrutinize the application for assistance to undertake awareness activity. Reasons for not selecting any organization/institution shall be communicated to the concerned authority.
- (4) The selected organization/institution shall involve the local Division/Range office of the E&F Department while preparing and conducting the awareness activity.
- (5) The organization/institution is required to submit the following documents after the completion of the awareness program
 - a. Audited Expenditure statement.
 - b. Utilization certificate (Annexure-E).
 - c. Scrutiny format in case of Seminar/Symposium/Workshop/Conferences.(Annexure-B).
 - d. Photographs of the event.
 - e. Copy of registration sheet (Annexure-C)in which the participants registered themselves for the awareness activity.
 - f. A detailed report on the awareness activity undertaken.
 - g. A brief reference on the impact of the activity among the participants based on the feedback submitted by participants and also by means of circulating a self-assessment questionnaire among the participants before and after the awareness activity shall also be included in the report.

Note: Assistance from the Environment &Forest Department may be requested for preparation of feedback/self-assessment questionnaire.

A model of self-assessment questionnaire is given as **Annexure – 'D'**.

Section 7: To Organize Nature/Eco-clubs in schools or locality:

It is a well-established and recognised fact that Young Students can be catalysts in promoting a mass movement about the ensemble of environmental issues. As future citizens, inculcation of environment friendly attitudes and behavioural patterns amongst them can make a significant difference to the long term efforts for protection of the environment. Children are triggers for a chain reaction, making a difference at the local and community level which in due course lead to awareness at village, city, State, country and global level.

The educational institutions shall avail grants for creation of such Nature Clubs/Eco Clubs and for organizing Nature Camp activities in Schools, Colleges, Universities and other educational institutions.

The Eco/Nature Clubs shall be registered with the department and the proforma of application for registration is given in **Annexure 'F'**.

The Nature/ Eco-Clubs shall undertake activities mentioned in Section 3. After completion of the activity, the person-in-charge of the nature club shall furnish a brief report along with the necessary documents such as photographs of the activity undertaken, UC, Scrutiny Format if workshops/conferences,etc was undertaken, feedback of the participants, etc.

The Nature camp activities inside PAs/Zoo shall be carried out with the necessary permission and assistance from the E & F Department. The application format for obtaining permission from the E & F Department is given in **Annexure 'G'**.
