**Performance** : Mizoram bagged 2 Gold Medals, 9 Silver Medals, 3 Bronze Medal (Total 14 Medals) and 3 Fourth place and scored 45 points, there by securing 17<sup>th</sup> position among 44 teams. (Last year's performance was 3 Gold Medals, 5 Silver Medals, 3 Bronze Medals, 4 Fourth place, scored 42 points, thereby securing 14<sup>th</sup> position among 37 teams) Chhattisgarh, Kerala and Madhya Pradesh stood first, second and third positions respectively (Details in Annexure).


