LAUNCHING OF GREEN MIZORAM PROGRAMME

Deeply concerned over the continued depletion of tree cover in the state resulting from excessive biotic pressures like illicit felling, forest fires, clearing of private and government lands for human habitation and other developmental activities, the government considered it necessary to launch a massive venture for resuscitation and afforestation of all barren lands in Mizoram including private, government and semi-government lands for converting such areas into green cover thereby creating a better environment. With this in view, the Govt. of Mizoram by Notification (Vide No.B.11023/13/98-FST dt. 6th May, 1999) constituted a State Level Committee on Green Mizoram under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Mizoram, Pu Zoramthanga. The Minister of Environment & Forests, Pu Rualchhina was the Convener. The composition of the Committee was given below:

District Level Committees were also constituted in all the eight (8) districts of the state under the chairmanship of the respective Deputy Commissioners with Heads of Govt. offices, leaders of Joint Young Mizo Association, Mizo Hmeichhe Insuihkhawm Pawl (Women’s Association), Mizoram Upa Pawl (Elders’ Association) and Heads of the educational institutions as members.

Broad functions of the State Level Committee and District Level Committee are:

- (a) To frame a policy where individual, family/ household, community, NGOs etc. will be involved in taking up tree planting.
- (b) To identify barren lands belonging to private, Govt., semi-government etc. for taking up tree planting thereon.

- (c) To create public awareness towards importance of tree planting, wildlife preservation, fire protection and conservation of nature as a whole.

The State Level Committee on Green Mizoram was reconstituted vide Govt. of Mizoram's Notification No.B.11023/13/2006-FST, dated 31st March, 2006 with Pu Zoramthanga, the Hon'ble Chief Minister as Chairman and Dr. R.Lalthangliana, Minister, Environment & Forests Department as Vice Chairman. Members are drawn from heads of selected departments under the Government of Mizoram, leaders of NGOs, prominent citizens and officials from Environment & Forests Department. The working committee, Sub-Committee on Green Mizoram was also reconstituted on the same date under the chairmanship of Pu N.Zokunga, Adviser to Chief Minister. Again, members were drawn from some government departments, NGOs, and officials of Environment & Forests department.

Each year, a particular day during the month of June is observed as 'Green Mizoram Day', dedicated for planting of trees and for maintenance of the trees planted in the previous years. Since its constitution in 1999, planting of trees have been carried out by the government departments, semi government departments, NGOs, educational institutions and public on identified locations which includes government lands, roadsides, private lands etc. And in the entire Mizoram, as many as 46,80,338 seedlings have so far been planted and distributed under Green Mizoram Programme upto 2024.

GREEN MIZORAM DAY 2024 CELEBRATION IN DIFFERENT DISTRICTS/DIVISIONS

Green Mizoram Day 2024 was observed on June 11, 2024 Tuesday with a theme, “*Plant Trees for your Life*” in the entire state of Mizoram. On this day a numbers of 15,472 trees were planted and 1,01,520 were distributed to the public. State level and district level celebrations of the Green Mizoram Day are as below:

Aizawl : The State – level inaugural function was held at Art & Culture Auditorium, Beraw Tlang, Zemabawk at 11:00 AM and was graced by Pu C Lalsawivunga, Hon’ble Ministers of AH & Vety etc. Pu Lalbiakzama, Assembly Speaker and Pu H Lalengmawia, IAS Commissioner & Secretary, also attended the function with senior officers from other Government Departments and NGOs. **MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL
SUB-COMMITTEE ON GREEN MIZORAM HELD
ON 16.5.2024 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF
COMMISSIONER & SECRETARY, EF&CC
DEPARTMENT**

A meeting of the State Level sub-Committee on Green Mizoram was held on 16.05.2024 at 12:00 PM in the Conference Hall of Forensic Science Laboratory, MINECO. The meeting was chaired by Commissioner & Secretary, EF&CC Department Pu H. Lalengmawia. The Chairman on his opening remarks highlighted the impact of climate change in the state and the crucial importance of creating awareness on this as it impact everyone, hence, spreading awareness among the mass population is required and observation of Green Mizoram Day is such one important activity. He also emphasised the need to pay attention on taking care of seedlings after plantation to ensure its success. The list of members and invitees who attended the meeting is appended as Annexure.

After welcoming the members and with a brief round of introduction, a detailed presentation on the activities carried out last year for celebrating Green Mizoram Day and agenda for the meeting was given by Pu Agni Mitra, CF (P&D).

1. Review of last year's performance

The Committee was informed that 29,839 no. of seedlings were planted on Green Mizoram Day, 2023 and 1,26,733 seedlings were distributed to various departments, institutions, NGOs, public, etc. In Aizawl, the State Level function was held on 9th June, 2023 (Friday) as the Green Mizoram Day i.e 11th June falls on Sunday. It was organized at

Sihphir and ceremonial planting was held at Sakawrhmutuai Tlang, Sihphir. Prizes were distributed to the best performing districts and villages for control / prevention of fire during the season.

2. Theme for Green Mizoram Day, 2024

It was decided that “I nunna atan thing phun rawh” or “Plant trees for your life” would be adopted as the theme for this year’s Green Mizoram Day.

3. Selection of venue for State Level Programme

After detailed deliberation by the committee, it was decided that Zokhawsang area, Assam Rifle’s Complex, would be the venue for organizing State Level Inaugural function of Green Mizoram Day, 2024 cum ceremonial planting. The committee also decided to invite Hon’ble Chief Minister as Chief Guest in the State Level Celebration.

4. Distribution of seedlings

It was decided that, as has been done in the previous years, seedlings would be continued to be distribution to public / NGOs/ Institution / departments, etc. who are keen to plant and care for the tree / seedlings. It was also decided that the planting agencies would submit report on success story / survival rate to the EF&CC Department. Govt, departments/ institutions and agencies having vacant land in their complex may utilise these spaces for planting trees on Green Mizoram Day, 2024.

5. Selection of best Districts for District Level Fire Prevention Award

The committee recommended that Fire Prevention Award to the best performing districts and Village Level Fire

Prevention Award for Aizawl district may be given on Green Mizoram Day as done in previous years. In addition, in order to recognise efforts made by individuals towards greening Mizoram, conservation of nature and wildlife cash award of Rs. 10,000 with citation may be given to 03 (three) individuals on State Level Inaugural function to be held on 11.06.2024. The EF&CC Department would formulate the criteria or terms of reference for selection and the State Level Sub-Committee on Green Mizoram may select the awardees.

6. Publicity

It was decided that message of Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Minister, EF&CC Department would be placed in print and electronic media and other activities such as relevant talk shows on radio and television may be organised. It was also decided to seek active participation of eco-clubs in various schools through Mizoram Pollution Control Board. Participation of various other educational institutions and Horticulture Department may also be explored for celebrating the Day in the befitting manner. I& PR and EF&CC Department may coordinate on preparation and dissemination of awareness to the public through social media platforms.
