The field biologist would be expected to :

- (i) Assist /carry out collection of data for NTCA Tiger Monitoring Phase IV & provide regular updates to NTCA Regional Office.
- (ii) Develop indices as to the health of eco-system of DAMPA Tiger reserve by carrying out 'SWOT' analysis.
- (iii) Carry out, document and publish report as to impact of management intervention on DTR
- (iv) Carry out any work Ancillary, Auxiliary and Incidental to working of forest deptt. of Mizoram.
