- 1. They shall monitor and ensure that all excavated soil from the construction works are dumped in soil banks identified for the purpose.
- 2. They shall ensure that the soil banks and muck dumping sites are managed and protected in such a manner that no soil excavated for construction projects cause damage and siltation to any land, lakes or rivers.
- 3. They shall aid Government Officials so that In-Principle Approval for the construction projects, issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, by User Agencies are complied to and ensured.
- 4. To ensure the safeguard of the environment on any matters with respect to the Implementation of JICA Funded Road Improvement Works of National Highway-54 in the five districts.
