The roles and responsibilities of the State Project Management Unit are as follows:

- 1. To select and appoint team of consultants in line with the relevant guidelines of Japan India Cooperation Agency (JICA) and Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India.
- 2. To prepare training guidelines and training improvement plans for Forest Training School.
- 3. To prepare training materials and JFM Handbook for Frontline Staff.
- 4. To rehabilitate Forest Training School in accordance with relevant guidelines and guadripartite MoU.
- 5. To select officers at Deputy Conservator of Forests/Assistant Conservator of Forests/Forest Range Officers level as trainers for Master Trainer's Training Programme.
- 6. To organize training of Trainers (w.r.t. SI. No. 5) and Frontline Staff.

The State Project Management Unit (SPMU) shall function from the Office of the Conservator of Forests (R&D) under overall supervision and control of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Mizoram.
